

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-7

**AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN
AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION AND TAKE ANY OTHER ACTION
NECESSARY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BULK PURCHASING
OF ROAD SALT FOR THE SUMMER AND WINTER SALT
PROGRAMS FOR THE 2015-2016 WINTER SEASON, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation has created a consortium of governmental entities to purchase salt to control ice and snow on Ohio’s roads; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that it is appropriate for Village of Waite Hill to purchase salt with other organizations, in order to take advantage of economies of scale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WAITE HILL, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into such agreements with ODOT and to take any other necessary actions to allow the Village to participate in the summer and winter salt purchasing programs offered by ODOT for the 2015-2016 winter season.

SECTION 2. That the actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Waite Hill.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Waite Hill, and for the reason that in order to obtain salt pursuant to the ODOT contract, immediate action is necessary because ODOT has provided an early April deadline for submission; wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment and approval by the Mayor.
