

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-01**

**AN ORDINANCE  
PROVIDING ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR EMPLOYEES OF  
THE VILLAGE OF WAITE HILL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Waite Hill desires to provide additional compensation to its employees for quality services rendered, based on donations that have been made to the Village by its residents for the purposes of making additional compensation to its employees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WAITE HILL, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That the Chief of Police shall receive additional compensation in the amount of \$8,500.

SECTION 2. That the Service Director shall receive additional compensation in the amount of \$6,500.

SECTION 3. That the Police Lieutenant shall receive additional compensation in the amount of \$5,650.

SECTION 4. That the members of the Service Department Brian Miller, Andrew Richards and James Riddle, full-time members of the Police Department Josh East, Marci Gedeon, Tyler Lillash and Ed Sedmak, and the Clerk-Treasurer shall each receive additional compensation in the amount of \$4,250.

SECTION 5. That the two part-time patrolmen shall each receive \$800.

SECTION 6. That the compensation authorized by this Ordinance shall be in addition to other compensation to the aforementioned employees provided by other legislation.

SECTION 7. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Waite Hill and, further, provides for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
