## **ORDINANCE NO. 2021-13**

## AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR EXPENDITURES AND OTHER EXPENSES FOR THE VILLAGE OF WAITE HILL, OHIO FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2022, REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WAITE HILL, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Waite Hill, Ohio during its fiscal year ending December 31, 2022, the following sums are set aside and appropriated as follows:

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That the Clerk-Treasurer be and is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payment from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved as by law to approve same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures, provided that no warrants shall be

drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further, that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended constituting a legal obligation against the Village, and for the purposes other than those covered by the specific appropriations herein made.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance, be, and they are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Waite Hill and further provides for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval of the Mayor.
